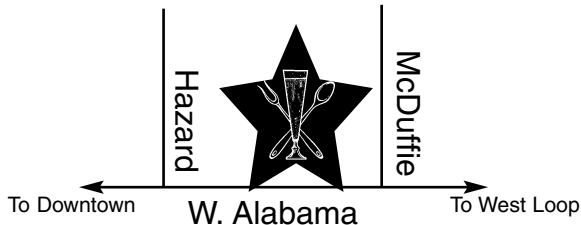

The Rules

- All events are free style. If it's a bean...any kind of a bean...it counts. Chili can be beanful or beanless...it's your call. Any part of a chicken counts, although necks are frowned upon. If it came from a pig....well, go ahead, we dare you. Wild game is defined as anything not domesticated, BUT no poached animals or road kill allowed. Imagination counts. It can be southwestern, oriental, cajun...even Polish.
- Each team will have a 10' square area for its booth and must bring its own table and cooking equipment. **Your equipment MUST include a tarp to cover your cooking area, a plastic “floor” for under your cooking area, 3 containers to hold water, bleach/water and soapy water for cleaning your utensils** for health considerations. For those using bar-b-que pits, your pit size will be limited to no larger than a 55 gallon drum. This is backyard cookin' at its best.
- Tasting cups, plates, forks and spoons will be provided by the MB&GC.
- Police security will be provided during the event. **NO guns** will be allowed, including “right to carry”.
- There will be access to running water, but NOT to electricity. No open fires will be allowed.
- Loading in will start at 8:00 am and run until 10:45 a.m. Vehicles must be removed as soon as load in is completed. There is ample parking available on side streets near the Ice House.
- Only cook teams are allowed to bring their own beer for their own consumption. Please avoid glass containers. The public will be purchasing from the Ice House.
- Pets are allowed. We ask that they be leashed.
- **Keep your cook site clean and clear your site of all equipment and garbage after the event. Garbage containers will be provided. The site will re-open to the general public at 7 pm, and there will be no security present to guard any of your possessions after that time.**

A silent auction will be held. If you have an item to donate, please bring it to the event with you.
